**YOU MUST NOT DRIVE
THIS CAR IF :—**

- (a) Your Driving Licence is out of date.
- (b) Your Driving Licence does not apply to this Class of Vehicle.
- (c) You are not sure that it is insured against Third Party Risks or you have not yourself a Certificate of Insurance which will cover you when driving it.

OTHERWISE YOU COMMIT AN OFFENCE.

DON'T DRIVE THIS CAR :—

- (a) Recklessly or dangerously, having regard to the state and condition of the road and traffic thereon.
- (b) If under the influence of Drink or Drug.
- (c) Off the road on to common land for a distance exceeding 15 yards except in emergency to save life or to extinguish fire.

OTHERWISE YOU COMMIT AN OFFENCE.

NOTE : Make yourself familiar with THE HIGHWAY CODE and carry out its recommendations. Failure to do so isn't an offence in itself but may be regarded as indicating negligence if any offence arises.

**IF YOU MEET WITH AN
ACCIDENT WHEN DRIVING
THIS CAR YOU MUST :—**

- (a) If you have damaged or injured any person, vehicle, or animal, report to a Policeman if one available. Failing that, report to a Police Station (preferably your Home Police Station) within 24 hours. It doesn't matter whether you are to blame or not.

OTHERWISE YOU COMMIT AN OFFENCE.

NOTE : Animal means Horse, Cattle, Mule, Ass, Sheep, Pig, Goat or Dog.

**EVERY APPLICANT FOR
A DRIVING LICENCE :—**

Must declare his physical fitness to drive.
The responsibility for this declaration rests upon the applicant and not upon any medical examination or Driving Test by the Licensing Authority.

OTHER OFFENCES :—

- (a) Failure to stop when required to do so by a Police Constable.
- (b) Taking or Driving other Vehicles without authority.
- (c) Tampering with the brakes or mechanism of other vehicles.
- (d) Aiding, abetting, counselling or procuring others to drive at an excessive speed.
- (e) Riding on or being towed by other vehicles without authority.
- (f) Leaving a vehicle at rest on a road in such a position as to be likely to cause danger to other persons using the road.

SPECIAL NOTES :—

- (a) If you can't produce your Driving Licence on demand by a Police Constable you may specify a Police Station at which you will produce it within 5 days unless you have been involved in an accident when you must produce it within 24 hours.
- (b) The same conditions apply to Insurance Certificates as to Driving Licences.
- (c) You don't commit an offence by failure to carry your Driving Licence or Insurance Certificate but you do commit an offence if you fail to produce them at the Police Station specified within the periods indicated.
